Our Annual Dinner this year features Ken Witkowski of the US Fish and Wildlife Service who will speak about the Shawangunk Grasslands, National Wildlife Refuge. The Shawangunk Grasslands NWR have been a birding hotspot this spring with reports of a Dicksissel, Grasshopper Sparrows and Henslow's Sparrows too. This unassuming area holds a wealth of species and Ken will speak about this birding gem.

Ken has been an avid birder for more than 30 years and served as past president of the Bergen County Audubon Society in New Jersey. He is a volunteer at the Mt. Peter Hawkwatch in Warwick, NY. He worked for New Jersey Audubon Society (NJAS) doing an avian abundance survey in the New Jersey Meadowlands and continues to lead field trips for NJAS.
